

## **ADVISORY NOTICE**

**ATTENTION:** General, Building, Residential, Electrical, Electrical Specialty contractors, owner/builders and interested parties:

### **RE: Permitting Low Voltage Systems**

The Florida Building Commission has confirmed, through the issuance of Declaratory Statement #DCA09-DEC-257, that a permit must be obtained for the installation of low voltage electrical systems.

Citrus County permit fees for low voltage systems installed in new houses or buildings while under construction are included in the fee calculation. A separate application with signatures and inspections are required.

Low voltage systems installed as “after-market” improvements, remodels, additions, etc., are subject to a \$50.00 permit fee, and require application signatures, and inspections.
